

Exhibition

The Huberty & Breyne Gallery in Brussels is delighted to be show-casing the work of Belgian artist Ever Meulen in an exhibition, which runs from 9 September to 9 October 2021, devoted to the *Brussels Travel Book* produced by the artist for Louis Vuitton.

Huberty & Breyne is offering Meulen's works for sale following an earlier exhibition of the artist's work, held at MAD - Home of Creators during the summer. Brussels has been a source of inspiration to Ever Meulen throughout his career and this exhibition features a total of 120 illustrations, all referencing some iconic element of Europe's great capital, from the landmark Atomium building to Tintin and Magritte, not forgetting the architectural wonders of the Grand-Place and the Stoclet Palace, the Vilvoorde Viaduct and Villa Empain.

"I chose to pay homage to Brussels because I owe everything to that city", Ever Meulen says proudly. "My heroes René Magritte, Hergé, Jacques Brel, Eddy Merckx, Jacky Ickx and Arno; but modernity likewise. I enjoy drawing things I know well: that's why I chose Brussels."

EVER MEULEN

Ever Meulen is one of the few graphic artists working in Belgium today to have made a name for himself as an illustrator of international renown. His multi-faceted work is an effortless blend of modern art and comic strip, a subtle balance of lines, shapes, vibrations and colours that combine to produce supremely elegant compositions, each of them a graphic tour de force.

Ever (Eddy) Meulen (1946) began his illustrating career working for the weekly magazine *Humo*, where he soon developed his own personal approach in his stylised treatment of pet topics - music, architecture, automobiles and typographical design. Decorative elements from the 1930s, postwar optimism and the exuberance of the 1950s all feed into his work, which allies formal mastery and a careful attention to style with graphic humour and playful allusions to the history of art.

Over the years, Ever Meulen has designed a great many posters, book and album covers, and also covers for The New Yorker magazine, his illustrations appearing widely throughout Europe as well as in the United States and Japan. In 2012, he received the Henry Van de Velde Award for Lifetime Achievement.

Brussels has always been central to his work, a real source of inspiration in terms not only of its architecture and its icons - the Atomium building, Tintin and Magritte, for example - but also of the city's cultural and creative institutions. Ever Meulen has been responsible for designing posters and visuals for major Brussels players like the Beursschouwburg arts centre, the Kaaitheater centre for performing arts, the Passa Porta International House of Literature, the publishers Édition Plaizier and the Brussels International Animation Film Festival.
